Public Hearing – Zoning Amendment

January 18, 2016

The Public Hearing for the Zoning Amendment was called to order by Chairman Mark McConnell at 7:00 p.m. in the Pittsfield Township Hall. Trustees Mark Diedrick and Forrest Mohrman were present as well as Fiscal Officer Tari Diedrick. Also present were Dan Shinsky, Maintenance Supervisor and eight guests.

Mark McConnell explained the zoning amendment regarding a change to concrete driveway requirements. The new language requires that concrete drives terminate three feet from the edge of the road pavement and be continued in either asphalt or gravel. There was discussion concerning the proposed change.

#16-23 RESOLUTION TO DEFEAT THE RECOMMENDATION FOR A ZONING AMENDMENT CONCERNING CONCRETE DRIVEWAYS

Motion was made by Mark Diedrick and seconded by Forrest Mohrman to defeat the recommendation for a zoning amendment concerning concrete driveways. After discussion it was proposed that the zoning rule remain as it is in the Zoning Policy Book. The motion passed on a roll call vote.
