Public Hearing – Zoning Amendment

January 13, 2014

The Public Hearing for the Zoning Amendment was called to order by Chairman Mark Diedrick at 7:30 p.m. in the Pittsfield Township Hall. Trustees Mark McConnell and Forrest Mohrman were present as well as Fiscal Officer Tari Diedrick. Also present were 9 guests.

Mark McConnell read the following zoning amendment proposed as an addition to Chapter 4-9, Section A:

“(8) No Pond, Lagoon, Impoundment area or Storage Vessel shall be constructed or used to store sewage, industrial waste, or human waste, treated or untreated in a residential, agricultural, or business district. Except for waste generated on premise either human, animal, or industrial.

This prohibition shall not apply to sanitary units approved by the Lorain County Board of Health or other agency with authority to approve sanitary unit installations.

A conditional use permit for such use may be issued to accordance with the standards set forth in Chapter 5 of this Zoning Resolution.”
